On-premise with EDR features would limit the vendor to join. Can we also include the Cloud console?	DSWD would prefer having an onsite management console that would manage all of DSWD's endpoints for both intranet and external via a public facing API due to sensitivity of possible data that can be logged by the endpoint agents. As for the Cloud-

agents		based console, DSWD believe there will still be such components integrated into the solution since DSWD also have a requirement covering protection of DSWD's Enterprise Email which is currently hosted with Google.

This solution must be a dedicated virtual machine / appliance capable of handling a least 1Gbps of traffic	If the Cloud console would be allowed, does the bidder needs to comply with Item 2.1.2.1.1? The bidder thinks this specification is only required for On-premise console for network traffic analyzer. Can the bidder offer a cloud class type of network traffic security analyzer? This also have the same features stated in Item 2.1.2.1.1.	This part of the requirements refer to the malicious Lateral traffic detection and mitigation within our network which DSWD believe cannot happen without direct interface with DSWD's core network devices, thus this requires dedicated on-site machine/ appliance that will serve as network probe and a possible separate service to do the analytics.
Item 2.1.1. Enterprise Endpoint Solution	Should the Endpoint be ready to support both Windows and Linux?	Yes, Endpoint solution must support both Windows and Linux.
Item 2.1.1.1.1. Management server should be able to support any of the following platforms and should include all required licenses (e.g. database software) to operate in an enterprise scale	What is the required set up of your Management server? (Cloud or On Premise)	On-premise for the end-point Management server.
