Bidder's Clarifications	DSWD Response
It states on the Bid Data Sheet that, Similar Contracts shall refer to Subscription to a Business Intelligence Software. Instead of this, can we use unrelated or any software project as a Single Largest Completed Contract (SLCC)?	No. Please note that the SLCC criterion of Sec.23.4.2.4 of the 2016 revised IRR of RA 9184 is required in order to ensure that the government is contracting with an entity that has accomplished at least one SIMILAR project with a value no less than fifty percent (50%) of the contract to be bid. Using unrelated or any software project as SLCC defeats this purpose. Thus, we would much prefer that "similar" contracts be indeed similar or related to the project.
Are the data that will be used for the BI software in a single database? Or is it in multiple locations/sources? Is there a need for the vendor to analyze each of the data sources (if multiple) and teach the DSWD how to organize it?	The data are from different sources and databases. Thus, we require that the software be able to connect to different databases (please refer to the TOR for further details). In doing so, the vendor must be able to provide tutorials about this on the users' training and as part of technical customer service support and on-site support.

V. Deadline for the Submission and Receipt of Bids

This is to reiterate the schedule for the deadline for the submission and receipt of bids is on **10 March 2021** at **09:00 AM.** Bids must be delivered to the BAC Secretariat Office, 2nd Floor, Mahusay Building, DSWD Central Office. **Late Bids will not be accepted.**
