A range of interventions to individuals, families, and communities in crisis or difficult situations, such as those affected by or vulnerable to disasters.

PROGRAMS

ASSISTANCE TO INDIVIDUALS/FAMILIES IN CRISIS SITUATION (AICS)

A social safety net or a stop-gap mechanism to support the recovery of individuals and families from unexpected crisis such as illness or death of a family member, natural and man-made calamities, and other crisis situations.
